- 1. This question recognizes all have sinned and are lost. (Rom. 3:10, 11, 23; 1 John 1:8; Rom. 6:23).
- 2. This question acknowledges **man must do something to be saved**. (Acts 2:40; Phil. 2:12; Rom. 10:12).
- 3. This question must be asked with the realization that we cannot earn salvation. (Rom. 6:23; Eph. 2:5, 8, 9).
- 4. This question comes in response to the God's love who gave His Son on the cross for all men. (Jno. 3:16; Rom. 5:8; 2 Pet. 3:9; Acts 10:34,35).
- 5. The Bible teaches that the **gospel**, the power of God unto salvation **is the answer to this question**. (Jno. 8:32; Rom. 1:16; Jas. 1:21; 1 Pet. 1:23).
